#### **RACE RULES & REGULATIONS**

#### Article 1. Organisation

Sundvolden GP is organized by Ringerike Sykkelklubb, Postboks 249, N-3502 Honefoss, Norway.

#### Article 2. Type of Event

Sundvolden GP is a international one-day race, organized according to UCI rules and classified as a UCI 1.2 Men elite event in the UCI Europe Tour. Riders and all cars in the convoy must follow the instructions of Police, race-marshals and respect the Norwegian traffic rules. All roads are open for normal traffic, but a rolling closure will be organized. According to UCI 2.10.008, points are awarded as follows for the UCI Men Elite ranking: 40, 30, 25, 20, 15, 10, 5, 3, 3 & 3 points to the first 10 finishers by time.

#### **Article 3. Participation**

As per article 2.1.005 of the UCI regulations, the event is open to the following teams: UCI ProTeams of the country, UCI Foreign ProTeams (max 2), UCI continental teams, UCI cyclo-cross professional teams, National teams, Regional and club teams.

According to UCI 2.2.003 teams must be formed of maximum 7 riders and minimum of 5 riders.

#### Article 4. Race Headquarter

The race headquarters will be open Friday  $5^{th}$  of May 2023 from 16:00-19:30 and Saturday  $6^{th}$  of May from 07:30-11:00. located at the following address: Sundvolden hotel, Dronningveien 2, 3531 Krokkleiva. GPS: Lat.: 60.062383 Lng.: 10.310428.

Team representatives are requested to confirm their starters and collect their race numbers and time transponders at the race headquarter from 16:00 to 18:30 on the 5<sup>th</sup> of May 2023. A fixed order of teams will be issued for the registration.

The team managers' meeting, organized in accordance with article 1.2.087 of the UCI regulations, in the presence of the Members of the Commissaires' Panel, is scheduled for 19:00 on 5 <sup>th</sup> of May 2023 at the following address: Sundvolden hotel, Dronningveien 2, 3531 Krokkleiva.

#### Article 5. Radio-Tour

Radio tour frequency: 154.925 mhz. Broadcasted in English.

#### **Article 6. Neutral Technical Support**

The neutral support is taken care of by 2 cars from the organizer.

#### Article 7. Classifications

There are no in-race competitions.

#### **Article 8. Prizes**

The following prizes are awarded: See page 7. A grand total of € 6050 will be awarded in prize money at the event.

#### Article 9. Anti-Doping

The UCI antidoping regulations are entirely applicable to the event. Moreover, and in conformity with the law of Norway, the Norwegian anti-doping legislation is applicable in addition to the UCI anti-doping regulations. Location of the tests if any will be announced. Selected riders for anti-doping control will be personally notified by a chaperon.

#### **Article 10. Awards Ceremony**

According to UCI 2.3.046 immediately after the finish the first three riders must take part in the official award ceremony.

The top three riders of the race may be asked to attend a press conference after the race.

#### Article 11. Sign On

All riders must sign on the protocol before the start. The protocol is posted 60 min. before the start and will be removed 10 minutes before the start. By signing on the start protocol the rider confirm that he has read and understand the race regulations and the route of the race.

#### **Article 12. Penalties**

The UCI penalty scale is the only one applicable.

#### Article 13. Riders abandoning the race

A rider who abandons the race shall immediately remove his race-numbers and deliver these to a commissaire.

#### Article 14. Team Cars

The driving order of the team cars are determined by drawing lots. All the vehicles driving in the motorcade are restricted to a maximum height of 1.66 m (art. 2.2.032). All Teams Managers, that are not present will take part in drawing the lots, just they will be for the last places. Only one vehicle per team will be permitted to circulate at race level.

All drivers are required to check the maximum weight load limit of the roof of their vehicles, and make sure that this limit not is exceeded. The sports director is according to the UCI regulations responsible for the team car. The driver of the car is the one responsible according to the Norwegian traffic regulations.

#### Article 15. Alterations

If it is necessary to alter any arrangements for the race, the Commissaire President, and the Race Direction will take these decisions.

#### Article 16. Feeding

All static feeding must take place on the right side of the road (UCI art. 2.3.026). Feeding from the team car is allowed between 30 km after start and until 20 km before finish. Due to atmospheric conditions etc, the Commissaires panel may reduce the distance before feeding commences from the team cars, furthermore, they may also extend the LAST 1000 M distance before feeding closes. Such a decision will be communicated to interested parties in advance of the race.

Feeding zone will be listed at the route description and maps.

#### Article 17. Time limit

Any rider finishing in a time exceeding that of the winner by more than 8% shall not be placed.

The time limit may in exceptional circumstances be increased by the commissaires panel in consultation with the organiser (UCI 2.3.039).

Riders more than five minutes behind the main bunch at the following checkpoints will be stopped:

Vikersund, 44,6 km Feeding zone, 79,2 km Engerkrysset, 97,5 km Engerkrysset, 134,2km Skaret, 148,2 km

The race direction and the Commissaire president will monitor the situation through the race and have the right to stop dropped riders earlier in the race to ensure the security of the race.

#### Article 18. Race numbers and transponders

Each rider has to put on two body numbers and one frame number. It is strictly forbidden to fold, cut or altered race numbers in any way. Information about time transponders will be given at the race HQ on the 5<sup>th</sup> of May when picking up the race numbers.

All teams with new riders at their team for Ringerike GP are to bring back the transponders of the riders not starting Sunday. Contact Jostein Tofte (timekeeper) at the race HQ Saturday night. Riders doing both races can keep their transponders the whole weekend.

The time transponders must be returned to Jostein Tofte (timekeeper) at the finish line after the finish of Ringerike GP on Sunday (situated in a small van behind the stage).










MAP – LAST 3 KM







